



Report from Personnel Ministry

Due to budget constraints the Personnel Ministry made the following adjustments:

- The Financial Administrator position has been eliminated with those duties being absorbed by the staff.
- The monies designated for Sabbatical Expenses were removed.
- The monies designated for training of support staff were removed.

The Session approved the following motions and requests:

- The changing of the Registered Agent for the Corporation from Jane Fobel to Joe B. Martin
- Mission Interpretation Ministry's recommendation to collect blankets and hooded towels to be used for newborn care in Bayonnais, Haiti. The collection will be for one month in 2018 with the date to be determined.
- Personnel Ministry's recommendation for an updated policy on Discrimination and Harassment Language used in the Personnel Handbook.
- Sardis Weekday School Steering Committee's proposal to fill two open positions with Jane Tilley and Emily Oelz.
- New summer hours: July 1, 2018 through September 2, 2018, there will be one worship service at 10:00 a.m. each Sunday.
- From the Sardis Gift Trust: Distribution of \$2,000 to "I Am 25/7", a nonprofit Mecklenburg Charity. The purpose of the money is to purchase materials to construct a storage shed. Construction of the shed will be performed by Sardis Men's Mustard Seed Groups.

Other Information

- Campus Signage: Joe B. reported that a group is looking at options to improve our campus signage. They have received three proposals. There will be taken to the Property Commission for a recommendation.
- Children's Sunday School room renovations: A committee, chaired by Lyn Sloan, with Katie Harrington, Margot Smith, Mary Beth Blackely, and Catherine Newman, has met to begin formulating suggestions/proposals for re-designing our children's rooms in the Education Building.
