



**The Session approved the following motions and requests**

- Calling a Congregational Meeting for Sunday, September 23, 2018 at 10:50 a.m. in the Sanctuary. The purpose is to elect Officers to the Class of 2021.
- The ordination and/installation of 2021 Officers on Sunday, January 6, 2019 at either 9:00 a.m. or 11:00 a.m.
- The wedding of Jim Parker and Ellen Wagoner on Sunday, December 8, 2018 in the Chapel. They are non-members, however, Jim Parker attended Sardis with his parents, members Bill and Leanna Parker before their deaths.
- The request from Deborah Atkins for transfer of membership to Second Presbyterian Church in St. Louis, MO.
- Remove Lindsay Baker Kazer from membership by her request.
- Christian Education Ministry for approval of Doyle and Linda Williams as Middle School teachers for the 2018-2019 school year.
- Youth Ministry recommendation for approval of Derek Orndrof to be a High School Youth Advisor.
- The Session Endorsed Sara Martin to be enrolled as an inquirer in the ordination process of the PC (USA).
  - The Session approved the use of the Sardis Christian Education Service Fund to help fund on third of Sara Martin's theological education for this school year.
- Approved the Property Commission's recommendation to remove the American Holly tree which blocks visibility of the Sanctuary from the south.
