



The Session approved the following motions and requests

- Youth Ministry's request of Jonathon Hetterly to lead a seminar on technology and social media for parents and high school youth on November 11.
- The Diaconate's request of the Session that the 2019 February and October meetings of Session be held jointly with the Diaconate for the purpose of restructuring orientation in February, restructuring review and 2020 adjustments in October, and Diaconate reports at both.
- Stewardship Ministry recommendation that Session adopt this statement of purpose related to the 2018-2019 Stewardship Theme: **Equipping Sardis for God's Mission**
