Why have we chosen to serve in St. Louis?

We have the opportunity to work with the Hands and Feet Initiative of the General Assembly, the highest governing body, of the Presbyterian Church (USA).



What will we be doing?

We will work around St. Louis as part of the Hands and Feet Initiative. This initiative was started so our denomination will have a positive impact on the city where our General Assembly meets. St. Louis is the first city for this experience. Our youth will work at various agencies in St. Louis, helping to be the hands and feet of Christ. We will also spend a little time at General Assembly, since it will be the week we are in St. Louis.



What are our travel plans?

We will stay in a house owned by Oak Hill Presbyterian Church, designed for groups to use for mission work similar to this. We will provide our own meals (a cook will accompany). We will have time to explore St. Louis and see some of the famous landmarks, including the arch. Due to the long drive, we will spend the night in Nashville, TN on the way to and from, exploring that city in the process.
